ART & CASTLE

6-hour tour including driver and guide

Meet your driver and guide in the lobby of your hotel, or by your cruise ship/airport and enjoy a beautiful ride along the shores, facing the strait between Denmark and Sweden, heading north of Copenhagen.

Visit to Kronborg Castle

We will experience the most famous and impressive castle in Danish history, Kronborg Castle. The castle has been the residence of the royal family and is furthermore also referred to as the Hamlet Castle, since this is where Shakespeare got his inspiration from, to write about Hamlet.

Lunch at Restaurant Sletten

Surrounded by fishermen's cottages and directly overlooking the harbor and the sea, the place oozes of charm and nostalgia. The restaurant is owned by the chefs behind Michelin-star restaurant formel B in Copenhagen.

Visit to Louisiana Art Museum

The Louisiana Museum of Modern Art is a 45-minute drive from Copenhagen. With a panoramic view across the sound, Louisiana is an international museum with a considerable collection of modern art.

The museum's permanent collection includes more than 3,000 works and is the largest in Scandinavia. It takes its point of departure in the period after 1945 including artists like Picasso, Giacometti, Dubuffet, Yves Klein, Andy Warhol, Rauschenberg, Henry Moore, Louise Bourgeois and Philip Guston.

Tour ends back in Copenhagen.









SHORE EXCURSION

4-hour sightseeing including driver and guide

Our Shore Excursion is perfect if you want to see the highlights of Copenhagen and only have a few hours. We will pick you up by your cruise ship, the airport or hotel, and bring you back after the tour.

Sightseeing on the first row

Copenhagen was founded in 1167 by Bishop Absalon. The city became the capital of Denmark in the 15th century, in the heart for the Danish empire.

We will make sure, that you will get a sense of historical Copenhagen, that makes you feel welcome and inspired to learn more about the natives.

Enjoy picturesque sites, charming canals, friendly people and quaint neighbourhoods that will make you feel at home.

JEWISH WALKING TOUR

3-hour Jewish walking tour of Copenhagen with a guide

On the Jewish city tour of Copenhagen, you will learn about the amazing story of Danish Jewry from when the first Jews were invited by the king Christian 4th in 1622, to present time. The Jewish guide will also share her personal stories about the miraculous rescue of 7,000 Danish Jews in October 1943 and about Jewish life today.

Visit to the Copenhagen Synagogue

The Great Synagogue of Copenhagen, is defined by its unique architecture. Since 1833 it has been the center for the Jewish Community in Denmark, and is still in use on a daily basis.

Copenhagen landmarks

At the same time, we will tell you about the many Copenhagen landmarks we pass on our way through the old city such as:


- Copenhagen's historic city centre

Visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum

Top architect Daniel Libeskind's characteristic architecture will - in an almost labyrinthine manner - lead you into the universe of the Danish Jewish culture. The Museum is named 'Mitzvah' honoring the rescue of the majority of the Danish Jews during WW2.

The tour ends after the visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum.









RESCUE ROUTE

5-hour Jewish tour including a driver and guide

On the Rescue Route your Jewish guide will tell you the amazing story of Danish Jewry from when the first Jews were invited by the king Christian 4th in 1622, to the present time.

During the tour we will pass Copenhagen Landmarks such as:

- Copenhagen's historic city centre
- The historic Round Tower
- Christiansborg Palace, The Parliament
- Strøget, the main pedestrian street
- Børsen, the iconic stock exchange
- The Little Mermaid, national symbol

Visit to the Copenhagen Synagogue

The Great Synagogue of Copenhagen, is defined by its unique architecture around the Ark. Since 1833 the center for Jewish life in Denmark.

Visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum

The top architect Daniel Libeskind's characteristic architecture will - in an almost labyrinthine manner - lead you into the enthralling universe of the Danish Jewish culture.

Visit to the fishing village of Dragör

Brave fishermen helped more than 95 % of the Jewish population in Denmark to safety in Sweden. Many Jews escaped from Dragør on small boats including the fishing boat K571 Elisabeth.

In Dragør your guide will share her personal stories about the miraculous rescue of 7,000 Danish Jews in October 1943.

The tour ends back in Copenhagen.









MEET THE VIKINGS

5-hour tour including driver and guide

Meet your driver and guide in the lobby of your hotel, cruise ship/airport, and head out for an amazing journey to the 1000-year old city of Roskilde, once the capital of Denmark.

Visit to the Viking Ship Museum

The Viking Ship Hall is beautifully placed on Roskilde Harbour. A giant window and sweeping views over the fjord creates a background, connecting the ships to the water, once again.

Feel the presence of history when you stand before the five original Viking ships that bear witness to war, trade and sea voyages to distant places.

Follow the work in the Boatyard, visit the large boat collection in the Museum Harbour. The great influence the Vikings had in Denmark and worldwide will be clear to you on this tour.

Lunch at Restaurant Rådhuskælderen

You will enjoy lunch at the Rådhuskælderen next to the Cathedral. The restaurant is located in the basement of the ancient city hall on the main square in the very heart of Roskilde.

Visit to the Cathedral of Roskilde

Experience an architectural masterpiece, where 1000 years of Danish history lies buried under beautifully decorated vaults and in dark crypts. You can explore the entire Danish Royal history in one place with the tombs of 40 kings and queens. Roskilde Cathedral has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995.

Tour ends back in Copenhagen.









CULINARY COPENHAGEN

2,5-hour walking tour including a guide and tastings

Food Capital of Scandinavia

On this tour you will discover local miracles, on a road trip through the historic Copenhagen.

Denmark has its own unique chocolate treat, the handmade cream puffs (called 'flødeboller') with a marzipan base and a thick coating of chocolate. Allow yourself to step into a chocolate paradise.

Visit to the Food market Torvehallerne

If you are looking for Danish and international delicacies, Copenhagen's popular market place Torvehallerne is a must. Here you will also enjoy a hand-picked seasonal tasting.

Lunch at Aamanns 1921

Going for lunch at Aamanns 1921, you will be served the famous Danish dish 'smørre-brød'. Rooted in the Danish lunch tradition but refined with new ideas and flavor combinations. You might want to add a homemade schnapps or a high quality beer.

A visit to Royal Copenhagen and Georg Jensen flag stores

You will be taken on a private tour with a leading staff member to experience Danish craftmanship. Be introduced to fascinating vintage pieces, modern exclusive jewelry and trendy kitchenware and learn about the principles of the essence of Danish design.
