# Art and Castle Tour

## Visit to Kronborg Castle

We will experience the most famous and impressive castle in Danish history, Kronborg Castle. The castle has been the residence of the royal family and is furthermore also referred to as the Hamlet Castle, since this is where Shakespeare got his inspiration from, to write about Hamlet.

## Lunch at Restaurant Sletten

Surrounded by fishermen's cottages and directly overlooking the harbor and the sea, the place oozes of charm and nostalgia. The restaurant is owned by the chefs behind Michelin-star restaurant formel B in Copenhagen. (Lunch is at your own expense)

## Visit to Louisiana Art Museum

The Louisiana Museum of Modern Art is a 45-minute drive from Copenhagen. With a panoramic view across the sound, Louisiana is an international museum with a considerable collection of modern art.

The museum's permanent collection includes more than 3,000 works and is the largest in Scandinavia. It takes its point of departure in the period after 1945 including artists like Picasso, Giacometti and Andy Warhol,

## **Chocolate heaven**

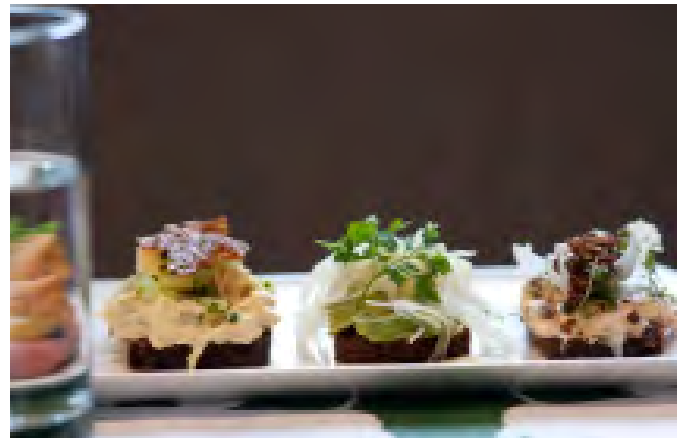

## Designmuseum Danmark

With a unique location in Copenhagen's historic centre, Designmuseum Danmark is a working archive and the entrance to Denmark as a design destination. Internationally acclaimed Danish designers Poul Henningsen, Kaare Klint, and Arne Jacobsen have left their indelible mark on Danish design and architecture.

## Lunch at Aamanns 1921

Going for lunch at Aamanns 1921, you will be served the famous Danish dish 'smørrebrød'. Rooted in the Danish lunch tradition but refined with new ideas and flavor combinations. You might want to add a homemade schnapps or a high quality beer.

## A visit to Royal Copenhagen and Georg Jensen flag stores

You will be taken on a private tour with a leading staff member to experience Danish craftsmanship. Be introduced to fascinating vintage pieces, modern exclusive jewelry and trendy kitchenware and learn about the principles of the essence of Danish design.

# From Occupation to Liberation

**3-hour tour including guide for 3 hours

We will take you back to early morning April 9, 1940. Nazi-Germany attack Denmark from the air, by sea and land. The occupation of Denmark has begun.

## Visit to the Resistance Museum

In the Resistance Museum we will walk in the footsteps of freedom fighters, the collaborators, the king, government and the daily lives of the Danes during World War II.

We will also tell the incredible story of how the Danish people rose up against the Nazis, by carrying out a rescue operation of the Danish Jews in October 1943

## Visit to The Citadel

You will be introduced to Denmark as a once powerful maritime nation with endless wars with Sweden. These stories will give you a perspective on why Denmark in the beginning of WW2 cooperated with Nazi-Germany, before the uprising in August 1943.

The Citadel in Copenhagen was founded by Danish King Christian 4 in 1626. Today, the buildings inside the Citadel are used as military barracks and offices. However, the beautiful area is open to the public and a favourite green lung for a brisk walk on the ramparts.

## Visit to the Memorial Park

Ryvangel Memorial Park on the outskirts of Copenhagen is a beautiful park, commemorating the Danish freedom fighters who were executed here or elsewhere, or died in German concentration camps, during World War II.

The tour ends back in the city centre.



# Jewish Walking Tour

**3-hour walking tour with a local Jewish guide - Price USD 475**

On our Jewish walking tour of Copenhagen, you will learn about the amazing story of Danish Jewry from when the first Jews were invited by the king Christian 4th in 1622, to present time.

The Jewish guide will share her personal stories about the miraculous rescue of 7,000 Danish Jews in October 1943 and about the terror attack against the Jewish Community in February 2015.

## Visit to the Copenhagen Synagogue

The Great Synagogue of Copenhagen, is defined by its unique architecture. Since 1833 it has been the center for Jewish life in Denmark.

The Copenhagen Synagogue was built from 1830-1833 by the architect professor G. F. Hetsch in semi-oriental classic style.

## Copenhagen landmarks

At the same time, we will tell you about the many Copenhagen landmarks we pass on our way through the city such as:

- Copenhagen's historic city centre
- The historic Round Tower
- Christiansborg Palace, The Parliament
- Strøget, the main pedestrian street
- Börsen, the iconic stock exchange

## Visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum

Top architect Daniel Libeskind's characteristic architecture will - in an almost labyrinthine manner - lead you into the universe of the Danish Jewish culture. The Museum is named 'Mitzvah' honoring the rescue of most of the Danish Jews during WW2.

The tour ends after visit to Jewish Museum.

On our Rescue Route 2, your Jewish guide will take you for a 3-hour Jewish walking tour, followed by a 2-hour visit by car to Dragör fishing village.

During the tour your guide will tell you the amazing story of Danish Jewry from when the first Jews were invited by the king Christian 4th in 1622, to the present time.

During the walking tour you will pass many Copenhagen landmarks such as:

- Copenhagen's historic city centre

- Christiansborg Palace, The Parliament

## Visit to the Copenhagen Synagogue

The walking tour includes a visit inside the Copenhagen Synagogue built in 1833.

## Visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum

The walking tour also includes a visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum "Mitzvah" to learn more about Jewish history in Denmark.

After the visit to the Danish-Jewish Museum you are picked up by a driver in a limousine/ van for a visit to Dragör fishing village.

## Visit to the fishing village of Dragör

Brave fishermen helped more than 95 % of the Jewish population in Denmark to safety in Sweden.

In Dragör your guide will share her personal stories about the miraculous rescue of 7,000 Danish Jews in October 1943.

The tour ends back in Copenhagen.





# Kings and Castles Tour

## Kronborg Castle - Where legends were made

Experience the most famous and impressive castle in Danish history, Kronborg Castle. The castle has been the residence of the royal family and is sometimes referred to as the Castle of Hamlet. It is said, that it was here Shakespeare gathered his inspiration to write his world famous play about Hamlet.

## Frederiksborg Castle - Renaissance splendor

Dating back to 1560 Frederiksborg Castle is perhaps the most impressive castle in all of Scandinavia. Situated on three islands surrounded by a lake and beautiful gardens, it's simply breathtaking. Frederiksborg Castle is home to the Museum of National History, and the walls of this mighty palace are full of rich history, architecture, and gardens.

Between the visits to the castles there will be a chance to enjoy a delicious lunch in a charming setting on our journey through the landscape of the northern part of Zealand.

## Visit to the Viking Ship Museum

The Viking Ship Hall is beautifully placed on Roskilde Harbour. A giant window and sweeping views over the fjord creates a background, connecting the ships to the water, once again.

Feel the presence of history when you stand before the five original Viking ships that bear witness to war, trade and sea voyages to distant places.

Follow the work in the Boatyard, visit the large boat collection in the Museum Harbour. The great influence the Vikings had in Denmark and worldwide will be clear to you on this tour.

## Lunch at Restaurant Rådhuskælderen

You will enjoy lunch at the Rådhuskælderen next to the Cathedral. The restaurant is located in the basement of the ancient city hall on the main square in the very heart of Roskilde.

## Visit to the Cathedral of Roskilde

Experience an architectural masterpiece, where 1000 years of Danish history lies buried under beautifully decorated vaults and in dark crypts. You can explore the entire Danish Royal history in one place with the tombs of 40 kings and queens. Roskilde Cathedral has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995.
